

“Eat My Flesh, Drink My Blood”

Words of Jesus Are Proven



New miracles of the Eucharist, in the last 25 years, in three countries have proven these words of Jesus: my flesh is real flesh, my drink real blood. Hosts, consecrated by a priest at Mass, have turned into real flesh and blood, the heart of a human being, in Poland, Mexico and Argentina—the latter country where Pope Francis—then a cardinal—was a key person in proving the eucharistic miracles of Buenos Aires.

Scientists and doctors who are world-famous were able to confirm that hosts turned into flesh were determined to be the

muscle (the myocardium) of the heart that gives life to the whole heart, just as the Eucharist gives life to those who consume it. Science found the left ventricle of the heart in hosts—the Eucharist—turned to human flesh. Why? Simply because from it comes purified blood, and Jesus Himself purifies the souls of those who receive Him worthily. Worthily means not in any serious or mortal sin as defined by the Church.

For hundreds of years, science has been proving, but can't explain how, the truth of miracles of the Eucharist, in over 100 cases, the oldest one being from Lanciano, Italy in 750 A.D., a sample from which was again proven in 1971 by Dr. Edward Linoli. Interestingly, the Medical Commission of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the United Nations (U.N.) published these findings five years later, in December 1976, and declared that science could only state what was found, but not how such a Eucharistic miracle could happen. No explanation was possible for these scientists, face to face with the limits of science.

ARGENTINA - The parish of Santa Maria of Buenos Aires was the site of three Eucharistic miracles that occurred in 1992, 1994 and 1996. The Archbishop at the time was the present pope, Pope Francis. On August 15, 1996, the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a consecrated Host fell to the ground, and was placed in a vessel of water to dissolve naturally. It didn't happen. Instead, upon opening the tabernacle door, it was discovered that the host had miraculously changed to blood. It started with reddish stains that became larger each day. An earlier miracle in 1992 at the same church found a top chemist to analyze the miracle of the change from the host—usually circular bread less than the size of a person's palm—to Blood. A capital B in Blood indicates to a believer that the Blood is Christ's Blood. The chemist found it was human blood and that it contained the entire leukocyte formula. She was also very surprised to observe that the white blood cells were active. In 1996 Dr. Castanon Gomez was in charge of the scientific investigation and he turned to top experts. The forensic Analytical Genetics Laboratory in San Francisco, California, U.S.A., found some fragments of human DNA in the sample, in other words human blood that contained the human genetic code. Later, Dr. Robert Lawrence found that the sample could correspond to the tissue of an inflamed heart. This meant that the person to whom they belonged must have suffered greatly. One of the greatest experts in cardiac pathologies and forensic medicine of the heart, Dr. Frederick Zugibe, confirmed that the sample is heart muscle of the myocardium. It is the left ventricle. The great doctor wanted to know who the sample was from, and when told it was a consecrated Host from a Catholic Mass, he could not believe it, but was greatly moved. Dr. Zugibe told Dr. Gomez that "at the moment you brought to me this sample, this heart was alive". And finally in 2005, the conclusion was that the Host that turned to Blood was the heart tissue, undergoing degenerative changes of the myocardium, and these changes are due to the fact that the cells are inflamed, and it is the left ventricle of the heart." On March 17, 2006, the results were given to Cardinal Jorge Maria Bergoglio, who shortly afterward became Pope Francis of the Catholic Church.

Before going to the next Eucharistic Miracle, a question may arise in the minds of readers; how can science say it is the Blood of Jesus Christ. It can't! That is beyond the limits of

science, which was created by God. But in two countries, India in 2001 and the island of La Reunion (a French colony) in 1902, the face of Jesus Christ appeared in the Host, seen by thousands in each place. These images are shown in the book “The Eucharistic Miracles of the



World” mentioned above.

MEXICO—In 2006, a great Eucharistic miracle occurred in Tixtla, Mexico, and the local bishop after all the scientific results were in, wrote “This manifestation brings to us a marvelous sign of the love of God that confirms the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist... In my role as Bishop of the diocese, I recognize the supernatural character of the events relating to the Bleeding Host of Tixtla... I declare the case a Divine Sign.”

On October 21, 2006, a reddish substance was noted as coming from a consecrated Host, during a Eucharistic celebration in Tixtla. The nun who held a ciborium during communion noticed that one Host was oozing a reddish substance. Later, in analyzing the Host, it was determined that this was human blood, type AB - same as the Shroud of Turin, in Italy. It was also confirmed that it was living cardiac tissue. Normally, after two days, the tissue dies, while here three months had passed, and this was inexplicable for science. The blood also matched

the AB blood proven from the miracle of Lanciano, mentioned above. The upper part of the Host showed some dry, coagulated blood and under it, fresh blood. This confirmed that the blood was not applied since it could not remain fresh for that long (2006 to 2010) in only the internal part of the Host. In this case, human DNA was found, but when the sequencing to extract the genetic profile was done, they never were able to obtain it. Theologians say that since Jesus did not have a human father (His father is God the Father) it is not possible to obtain His genetic profile. And again, as elsewhere, studies proved the tissue corresponds to heart muscle, the myocardium specifically.

POLAND—This eucharistic miracle took place in Sokolka, Poland in October, 2008. A host that fell on the floor during communion had some strange red dots in the center, and after being placed in water and put in a tabernacle, a week later the Host was almost dissolved. Only a small piece was left, tightly connected to the red substance that had appeared on its surface. Over time the Host seemed to fuse with the corporal cloth and the red clot dried. Then two well-known scientists of global fame , specialists in pathological anatomy, were consulted. This was January, 2009. Dr. Sulkowski and Dr. Sobaniec-Lotowska found numerous biomorphological indicators typical of cardiac muscle tissue, including the phenomenon of segmentation, namely damage to the heart muscle fibers where communicating junctions are found, characteristic of heart muscle. They also found fragmentation, damage visible in the form of numerous small lesions. These alterations can be observed only in fibers that are not dead, but alive, and show signs of the fast cardiac muscle spasms typical of the last phase preceding death. Moreover, the heart tissue was joined to the consecrated Host in an inseparable manner. The material was in all respects cardiac muscular tissue.
