


Virgin Mary's Warnings in Rwanda, Africa Are Ignored -- 800,000 Murdered

Imagine what it's like to live in a state or country where over 800,000 of its citizens are murdered, most by machete including decapitation, heads and bodies everywhere. That's what happened in Rwanda, Africa, where they were warned by messages from heaven -- and almost everyone chose to ignore them.

The Virgin Mary pleaded with those present at her apparitions to help spread the messages to the world. The warnings and call to prayer, especially the rosary, were almost totally ignored.

A few listened to Jesus and Mary. In her book aptly titled "If Only We Had Listened", Immaculee Ilibagiza has now taken to the world the messages of Jesus and Mary. She herself lost her mother, father and brothers -- all victims of

the genocide.

The Vatican has approved the Rwanda appearances of Our Lady of Kibeho. This was done in 2011. Our Lady said, "If I am now turning to the parish of Kibeho, it does not mean that I am concerned only for Kibeho or for the diocese of Butare, or Rwanda, or for the whole of Africa. I am concerned with and turning to the entire world," said Our Lady, who urged the rosary to be said to stave off the horrors that did follow. Few listened to her dire requests.

Part of the messages of Jesus and Mary are cited here. We need to pay attention to them. Each has to do his or her part in prayer. One of the prayers given by Mary is the Rosary of the Seven Sorrows of the Virgin Mary, well-known many years ago, and given to Marie-Claire in Kibeho, Rwanda. Many Catholic stores sell that unique rosary. It has seven Hail Marys for each of the seven sorrows.

Most people should however pray the rosary they have available and the one known everywhere. The key thing is to pray the rosary every day. And Jesus Christ must be the center of your life, for He is your Lord and Savior, the Son of God and the judge of everyone at death.

Messages from Heaven at Rwanda

From Jesus and Mary

“You must begin your prayers by offering God all you conceal in your soul. God sees your every action and knows your every thought; you can hide nothing from Him. But you must tell Him yourself; you must be willing and strong enough to confess all your transgressions of body, mind and spirit to Him. Hold back nothing, admit all your bad deeds and thoughts. Then you must ask for God’s forgiveness from the bottom of your heart.”

“Rest assured that if you confess and seek forgiveness sincerely, He will forgive you. By beginning this way, the sins you carried will not distract you from praying sincerely. You can then speak to Him knowing that your heart is clean and your conscience clear. Pray to Him fervently, make a petition, beg His favor, ask for His blessing: God sees your heart and knows you seek His help with a repentant heart.”

“Be patient with all people, because God is patient with you.”

“Those who go to Heaven are those who have struggled to get there.”

“Prayer should be accompanied by deeds.”

“I ask you to work in order to benefit yourselves. You also work for the men you live with and you work for God. Follow the law that God has given you and that you have received and accepted willingly. Work for God, whom you have promised to serve. If you do not honor your commitments, if they remain mere words, what will you answer to God when He asks you about them? This is what will condemn you.”

“The one who turns to God in this world, and lives according to God’s will, can, through Divine Mercy, shorten and even avoid his time in purgatory.”



“I have come to prepare the way for Him, for your own good, and yet you do not want to accept, you do not want to understand. There is so little time remaining, yet you still allow yourselves to be distracted by earthly goods and desires, which will soon all pass away. I see so many of my children going astray, and so I come to plead with them, and to show them the correct way.”

“All of you, run to me. I am the best way to Jesus.”

“Dear children, who I love so much: I give you all my blessing. Not only for those who have come to Kibeho, but that it may spread throughout the world.”

“My daughter, you are being sent on a mission of love. You will remind the world of my Son’s great mercy and the boundless love He has for His children. Tell them that He offers their souls peace and their hearts happiness beyond imagination. Plead with them to pray to their heavenly mother, for I will give them strength they need to open their hearts to Jesus and let His love wash away their sins and despair. Tell them to accept His love, and they will receive eternal joy. Now go, my child, and preach the loving Word of the Lord.”

“This world will come to an end and man must prepare himself while there is still time. When I return to the earth, the soul will find the body it had before, and then each man will present before me an account of his own life. Those who have done well will gain the reward of heaven. Those who have committed evil will automatically condemn themselves by these evil deeds, and will not even seek to appeal against this, their own judgment. Tell all men that there is not too much time left. I will return soon,” said Jesus.

“What I am asking you to do is to repent. If you say the Rosary of the Seven Sorrows and meditate on it well, you will find all the strength you need to repent of your sins and convert your heart. The world has become deaf and cannot hear the truth of the Word. Today people no longer know how to apologize for the wrong they do through sin. They put the Son of God on the cross again and again.”

“Prepare yourself for the coming of the One who will come unexpectedly, and do not leave Him standing at the front door. He has a power that surpasses your intelligence and He sees even that which you want to hide from Him.”
